Who Shall be our Digital Guardian as Indigenous Entrepreneurs?	<p>A lack of engagement among indigenous peoples in the digital sector is widespread, and yet, a common desire among them is also evident to change this. In New Zealand, the government supports improving Māori participation in the digital sector.</p> <p>Māori themselves seek mastery in the digital sector. This paper contributes to the emerging theme of Māori digital leadership from a perspective that is values-based and grounded in a Māori worldview. This paper considers the role of atua Māori (traditional Māori spiritual beings) for the protection of Maori and non-Māori as we encounter the digital realm.
