Qualifications:

- Books must have been published between January 2020 and December 2024.
- Authors do not need to be members of SIM.
- Textbooks are not eligible.
- Edited books with multiple authors are not eligible.
- Maximum one book per author.
- Books rejected in previous years are not eligible for resubmission.

Nominated books will be evaluated based on the following:

- Relevance to the SIM domain.
- Contribution to the field.
- Empirical and theoretical rigor.

The following information must accompany each nomination:

- The title of the book and name(s) of the author(s).
- The year of publication.
- The publisher.
- A PDF copy of their book (**electronic links and hard copies will not be accepted**)
